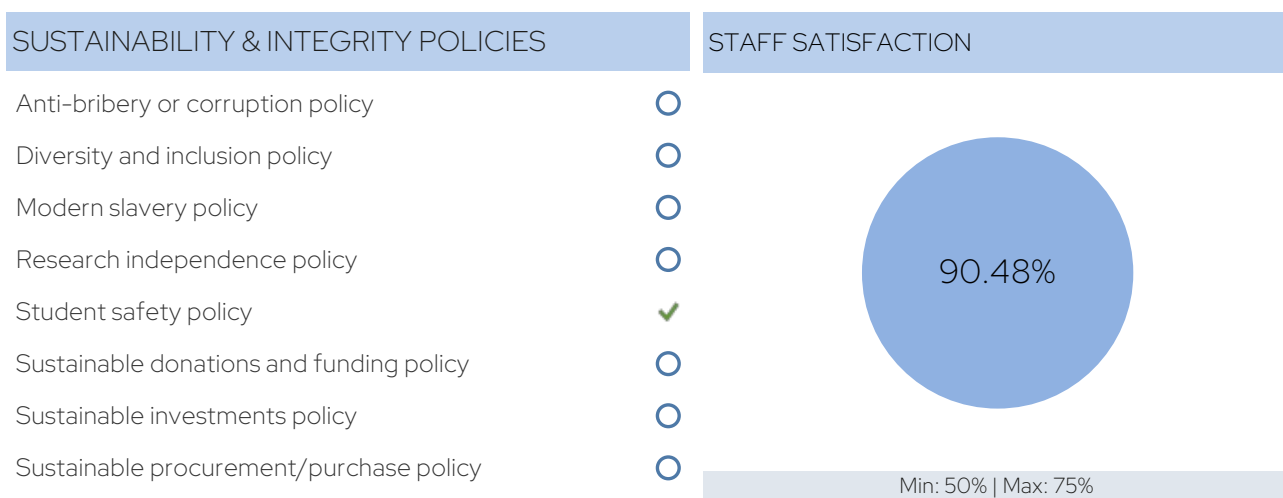
Sustainability

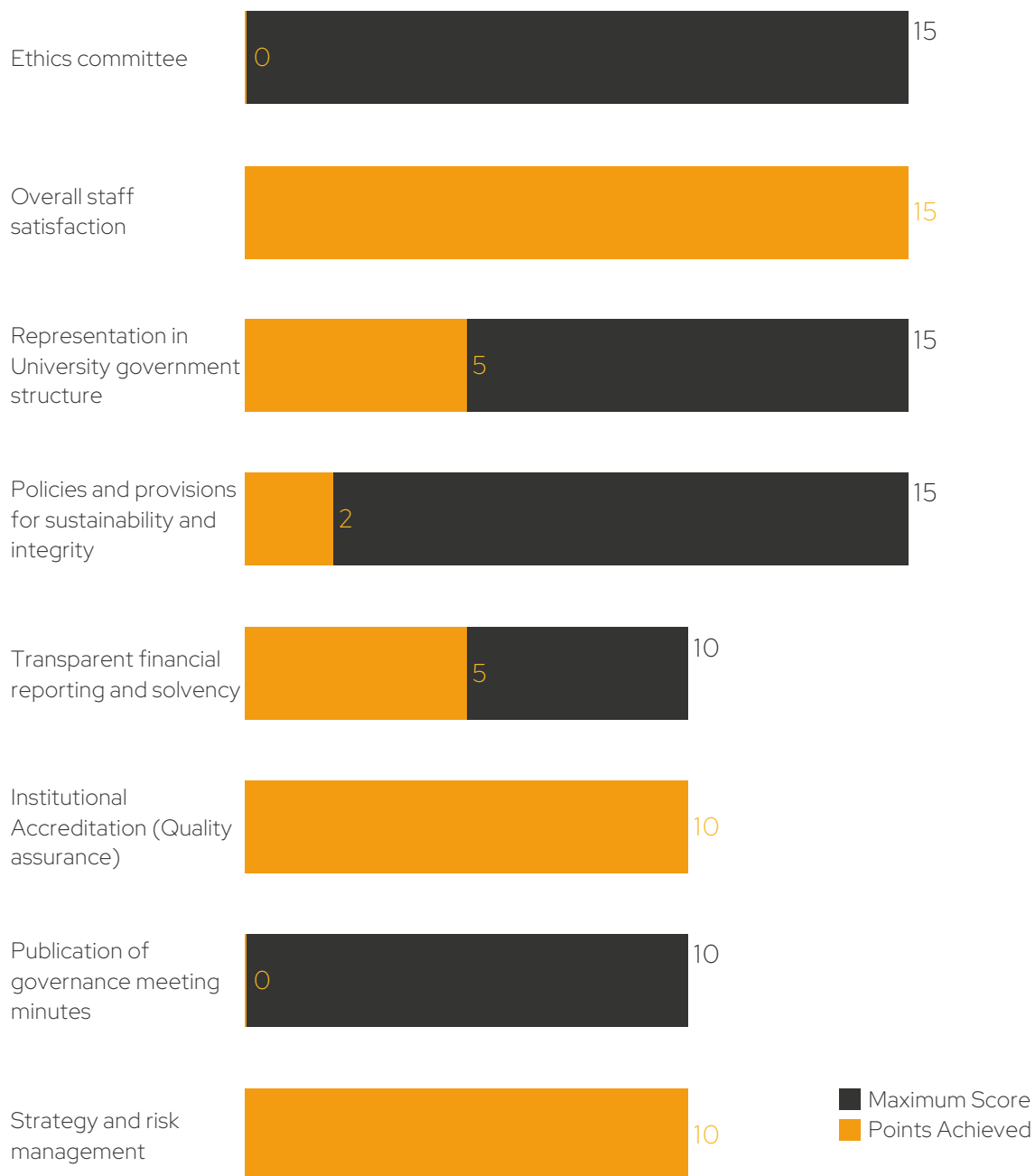



Social impact

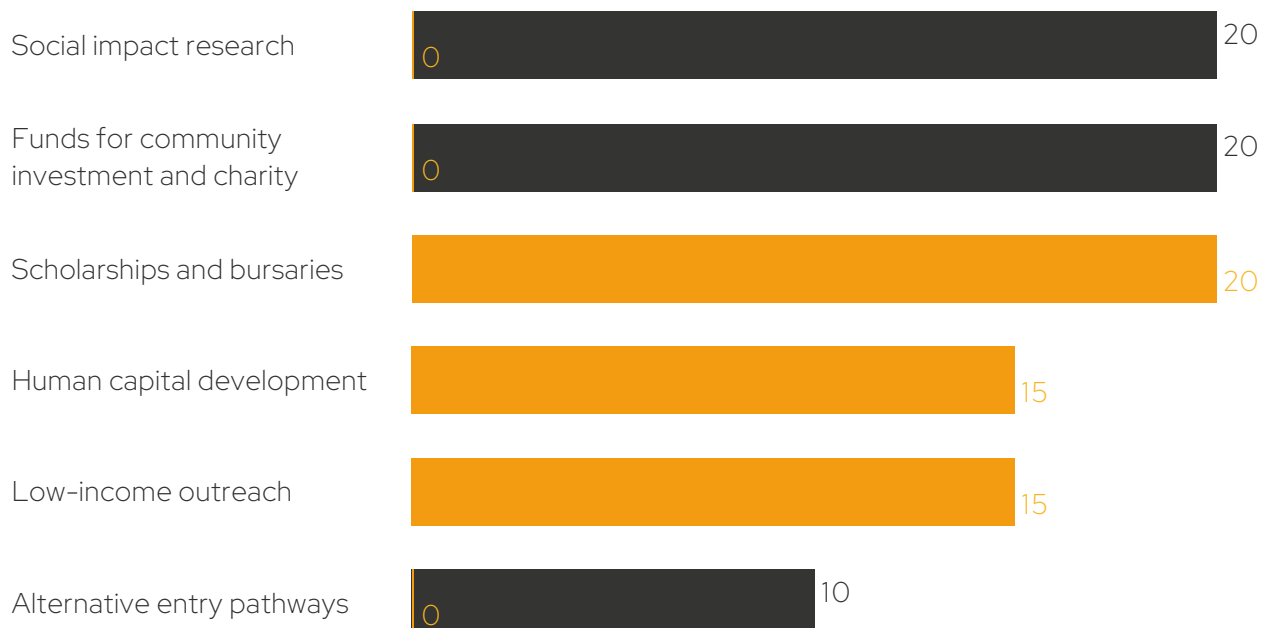

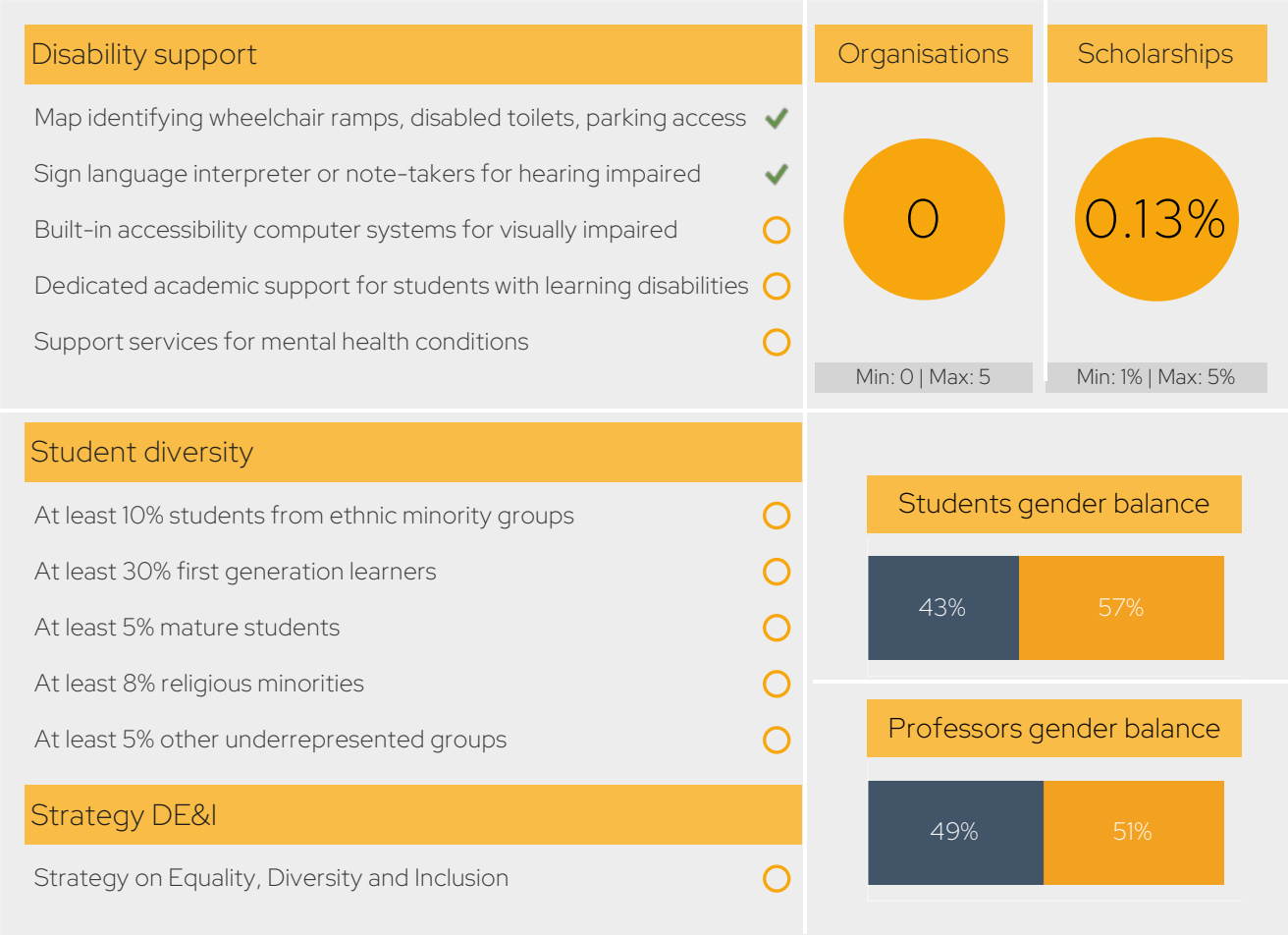

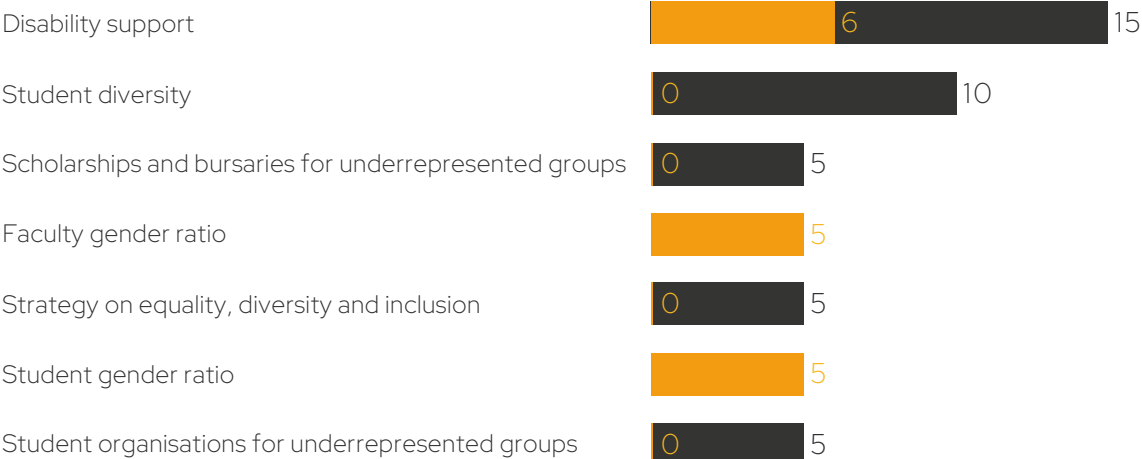
Diversity, equity & inclusion
